List and Criteria – Award

Distinguished Alumni Award

Award presented to members of the Alumni Association who, by their personal example, have exhibited the highest standards of individual achievement in professional and/or personal endeavors; who have demonstrated loyalty and support of this institution; and who, through dedicated service, have contributed to the advancement of all humanity.

No candidate shall be considered eligible for the award prior to the completion of 10 years' status as an alumnus/a of this institution.

Old Main Award

Award presented to UF alumni who have demonstrated distinctive achievements in a chosen career, civic involvement and/or service to The University of Findlay and have not reached the age of 36. The recipients of this award shall be eligible to receive the UF Distinguished Alumni Award at a later time.

The Gold Medallion Award

Award presented posthumously to deceased alumni who had superb records of distinguished career accomplishments and had made outstanding contributions to their professions, to their University and/or to their communities but had not been appropriately recognized by the University prior to their deaths.

The Arch Award

Award presented to a member of The University of Findlay community who, by personal example, has demonstrated loyalty and support of this institution. The recipient of this award must have a total of 15 years or more of service to The University of Findlay and must not hold an earned degree from the institution.

Honorary Alumni Award

Award is the highest honor given by The University of Findlay. The award shall be presented to individuals who are not graduates of The University of Findlay and who have made significant contributions to the University's welfare, reputation, and prestige. Awards may be granted at any time during the academic year and up to two annually.

Award Nomination Process & Form

General Criteria:

- 1. Current members and families of the Alumni Board of Governors.
- 2. The nominations are reviewed by the Recognition Committee of the Alumni Association Boardof Governors.
- 3. Award nominations will be carried over for three years, if not selected the first year of nomination consideration or until relevant age limitation is reached.
- 4. Recipients are expected to return to campus to attend the awards ceremony for which they are being honored.

Any interested person may submit a nomination for a Findlay College/University of Findlay Alumni Award.

All nominations should include the following

- 1. Completed nomination form (by nominator)
- 2. Supporting information (Alumni Office will request from the nominee):
 - a. Resume or professional vita
 - b. Articles by or about the nominee
 - c. Any other documents supporting the nomination

All nomination forms and materials submitted, along with additional research from our Advancement Services Prospect Research department, will be provided to the Recognition Committee of the Alumni Association Board of Governors. A letter of congratulations will be sent to selected award recipients and a letter of regret to all nominees who were not selected as award recipients.
